KENYA - HEAD COACH REPORT

The normal school sessions were conducted as usual during the school hours with community advance sessions over the weekends to focus on a certain group of selected players to advance their skills. Whilst in Muranga during my subsequent visits we created interest from a group of an alumni group that ended up helping Matthias in running sessions both on and off the normal school routines..

In Nairobi just like Muranga the approach was similar with school sessions and weekend programmes running... addition to this we were able to play internal matches every weekend at Unity mixed teams .

With the onset of the Nairobi based league....I managed to secure a sponsorship to field both men's and ladies team in the Nairobi based league which was played on Saturdays and CK also sponsored a team under CK development....I was in charge of all the teams and every weekend we participated in an eight based league format which we played one leg only with the top four teams qualifying for the semi finals (which are to be held this weekend)... unfortunately none of the development teams made it to the knockouts but a good exposure as first timers.

Nairobi hosted the under 19 women's league prior to the current qualifiers in Rwanda with an aim to select a squad to represent Kenya....Muranga Girls and Nairobi girls actively participated with Nairobi producing 7 girls and Muranga 1 and Nakuru 1...

All three regions later on during the August holiday programme....played a league format that saw teams actively participating in a 15 over matches every day....the aim was to give exposure and enough game time unlike what we are used towith this idea 8 counties under CK ended up adopting the same approach....

Muranga 6 schools under Matthias has really benefited from the programme and they have become young ambassadors of the game under Muranga county

Our ideas and the way we handle the 3 regions from school sessions to holiday camps....injected a bit of life on how CK should go about the other regions....prior to the just concluded county leagues which you have been actively part of as well as apart of our hub competitions gave life to what you witnessed across the 9 counties across Kenya as far as Cricket development and competitions is concerned.

We should be proud of what we have accomplished....with 9 girls representing our country at the ngoing qualifiers in Rwanda is a clear indicator of what impact we are creating at the ground....I suggest we think of a way of actively engaging the young lads and pick a lot to frequently work with especially on Batting....it has taken us close to 6 years to build and prepare the under 19 team....for sure the great have fallen along the way...but we have retain the current lot ... focus more on batting drills and patience to stay on the wicket ...

JUN/JUL/AUG HIGHLIGHTS

From June to August, we successfully completed two major events: the Girls Inter-Hub (Siraha-Saptari-Morang) and the Parents Workshop. We also continued with our school and community sessions. Here are some details about the events:

Girls Inter-Hub (Siraha-Saptari-Morang)

Originally, we planned to hold separate Girls Inter-Hub events for Siraha-Saptari and Morang-Saptari. However, we decided to combine them into one event. The tournament featured teams from three districts competing in a T20 cricket format. The event took place from April 30, 2024, to May 3, 2024. Over four days, the first three days were dedicated to league games, with the final game occurring on the fourth day. In the final, Morang faced Saptari and emerged victorious, winning the title.

The tournament was conducted with a strong focus on safety and inclusiveness. Players had the opportunity to interact with both national and international players, which significantly boosted their confidence both on and off the field.

Parents Workshop

We initially planned to conduct two Parents Workshops in Saptari—one in Rajbiraj and another in Khadak & Surunga combined. However, we were only able to deliver a successful workshop in Rajbiraj. Due to the rainy season, many parents, who are primarily farmers, were occupied with planting rice and could not attend.

Community and School Sessions

We continued to run both Community and School sessions, maintaining a high level of inclusivity and engagement. School sessions saw significant participation from students, while Community sessions attracted both current players and new, interested participants.
